## Coordinated Veteran Care (CVC)

CVC plans are coordinated, proactive treatment plans that involve input from your GP, and can include other allied health and specialists, depending on your healthcare needs.

- » Chronic diseases such as diabetes, heart disease, and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)
- » Neurological conditions such as Parkinson's disease, multiple sclerosis, and stroke
- » Musculoskeletal conditions such as arthritis, back pain, and joint pain
- » Cancer and other life-limiting conditions.
